





Ukrainian-German Cooperation in 2021 and 2022

For Students and Graduates

Future for Ukraine

- ✓ Scholarships for Ukrainian students (B.A., M.A., PhD) in Germany at 31 universities
- ✓ Language courses and subject-related training measures
- ✓ Possibility to carry scholarships over to a Ukrainian institution
- Extra-curricular activities preparing students for taking part in building up Ukraine and promoting German-Ukrainian cooperation

Leonhard Euler Programme

- ✓ Sur-place scholarships for M.A. and PhD students in their final year, combined with a research stay at the German partner institution (up to 3 months)
- ✓ Mobility grant for supervisor up to 7 days for joint thesis supervision in Germany

Prerequisites:

- Subject-specific research cooperation between the Ukrainian and German university
- Joint supervision of theses

Deadline: January 2024 (tbc.)

Prerequisites for DAAD Projects

- ✓ Application for funding by German university only
- ✓ No funding without cooperation agreement (or Letter of Intent)
- ✓ Funding mainly for mobility never for infrastructure



Support for the Internationalization of Ukrainian HEIs

1: Shaping the Digital Future Together: German-Ukrainian HEI Cooperation Projects

- ✓ Internationalization by fostering exchange and knowledge transfer
- ✓ Establishing regional teaching and research networks between German and Ukrainian HEIs
- ✓ Development of digital teaching and learning programs
- ✓ Training measures for the improvement of digital competencies
- ✓ Development of digital competences at the participating Ukrainian partner universities
- ✓ Scholarships for participants

Support for the Internationalization of Ukrainian HEIs

2: Continuing Education Programmes for Administrators at Ukrainian HEIs in Education and Academic Management

- ✓ Promoting structural optimisation in the field of higher education management and administration
- ✓ Training in the field of higher education management for Ukrainian university administrators
- ✓ Networking of participants within and outside the Ukrainian higher education area

2 projects currently funded (2021-2023)





"Ukraine digital": Ensuring Success in Times of Crisis

- ✓ Support of virtual courses for Ukrainian students with credit recognition by partner universities
- ✓ Integration of (refugee) faculty of Ukrainian partner institutions into teaching process
- ✓ Building expertise for further digitalisation of participating German and Ukrainian HEIs and professionalisaton of digital teaching
- ✓ Community building: Joint development of a digital internationalisation network



SDG-Partnerships

Areas of Activity:

- ✓ Teaching
- ✓ Research (only in connection with Teaching or HE Management)
- ✓ Higher Education Management

Funding for:

- Development of course materials
- Courses, workshops, internship, including mobility expenses





Eastern European University Partnerships (OP)

Eastern European University Partnerships

- ✓ Free choice of cooperating universities and subject areas
- ✓ Flexible activities (exchange of students, faculty and administrative staff, conferences, workshops)
- ✓ Funding for students up to 6 months, for faculty up to 1 month
- Many universities are already funded in the OP programme one application per university!
- Contact: International Office of participating universities
- Beadline: February 2024 (tbc.)



Study Programmes Taught in German (DSG)

Development of a course of study taught at least partially in German

Funding for:

- Development of course materials
- Language instruction
- Student exchange (up to 6 months), faculty exchange (up to 3 months)
- Sur-place scholarships
- Summer schools and study tours

Deadline: September 2024 (tbc.)



"Germanistik" Partnerships (GIP)

Goals:

- Development of contempoary and regionally relevant curricula for German Language and Literature/ German as a Foreign Language
- Training of junior researchers (PhD schools)

Funding for:

- Student and faculty exchange
- ✓ Tutor from the German university at the partner institution
- ✓ Development of PhD schools Sur-place scholarships for PhD students
- Conferences and workshops





East-West-Dialogue

- ✓ Organisation of conferences, summer schools, workshops, with one or several partner universities from Ukraine, Moldova, and countries from the South Caucasus and Central Asia (CIS).
- ✓ Focus on civil society and conflict resolution
- ✓ Location: Germany or partner country
 - Livents with a Ukrainian partner can be hosted in a third country within the region.
